INTRODUCING MSC VIRTUOSA

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MSC Virtuosa is the fourth ship in the Meraviglia generation and the second Meraviglia-plus ship. With an additional 16 metres, this enlarged and enriched ship features even more public space and more cabins. **MSC Virtuosa** has been named to pay homage to the skill and expertise of MSC Cruises architects and shipyard partners at Chantiers de l'Atlantique who designed and built this innovative class of ships.

Rich in onboard features, *MSC Virtuosa* offers MSC Cruises' guests a wide range of entertainment, dining, relaxation, shopping and other features as well as the MSC Yacht Club "ship within a ship" concept for those seeking exclusivity and privacy within a world of choice.



ONE OF THE MOST ENVIRONMENTALLY CONSCIOUS SHIPS AT SEA

MSC Cruises is committed to building some of the most innovative ships in the world – and this innovation also applies to their environmental performance. With a long-term goal to achieve a zero-impact cruise operation, each new ship MSC Cruises launches represents another step towards this goal, alongside other investments to help accelerate the development of next-generation environmental technology.

MSC Virtuosa features some of the most advanced technology currently available and has also received **11 Golden Pearls** from Bureau Veritas for her range of innovative aspects including environmental protection and health and safety.

MSC Virtuosa is also the first cruise ship in the world to receive a **BIORISK** notation from Bureau Veritas in recognition of her ability to mitigate and manage infectious disease risk for passengers.

Environmental technologies

Hybrid exhaust gas cleaning system: this technology achieves a 98% reduction of sulphur oxide (SOx) emissions.

Selective catalytic reduction system: SCR systems reduce nitrogen oxide (NOx) emissions from the exhaust by 90%.


Shore-to-ship power: allowing the ship to connect to local power grids while at ports where this infrastructure is available. This allows to minimise engine use at berth, leading to a substantial emissions reduction when the ships are close to urban areas.

Advanced wastewater treatment systems: designed in line with the International Maritime Organization's MEPC 227(64) Resolution, with purification standards that are higher than most wastewater treatment facilities ashore. Ballast water treatment systems will prevent the introduction of invasive species in the marine environment through ballast water discharges.

Underwater radiated noise management system: with hull and engine room designs that minimise acoustic sound impact, reducing their potential effects on marine fauna, most particularly on marine mammals in the surrounding waters.

Waste management centre: Our cruise ships produce from 20 to 35 cubic metres of waste every day so it's really important to separate, compact and reduce trash as much as possible. In our water management centre, we divide all waste into seven main categories (plastics, food leftovers, domestic waste, cooking oil, ash, electronic waste and operational waste). We have special machines and procedures to shred, compact or densify each waste category, so it can be adequately stored on board before it can be offloaded at port to de recycled.

Energy Efficiency: All MSC Cruises' newbuilds incorporate a wide range of energy efficient equipment that help reduce and optimise engine use. These include smart ventilation and advanced air conditioning systems with automated energy recovery loops that redistribute heat and cold to reduce demand, special hull paints that reduce drag and many others. The ships use LED lighting controlled by smart management systems to enhance further the energy-saving profile. In partnership with the shipyards, all new builds are fitted with remoteenergy monitoring and analysis systems, allowing real-time shoreside support to optimise operational efficiency onboard.

The enhanced health and safety measures are designed to ensure that MSC Cruises preserves the holiday experience from booking to on board. THE MSC CRUISES' ONBOARD EXPERIENCE



MSC Cruises will preserve the uniqueness of the onboard experience whilst ensuring that the health and safety of the quests and the crew are protected. MSC Cruises will organise activities to ensure that quests can practice responsible social distancing. Face masks will be required when in public areas, however masks do not need to be worn when seated in restaurants, bars, lounges, and when sitting on the sun deck.

Guests will continue to enjoy unique experiences including award-winning shows, worldclass dining, excursions, family activities, boutique shopping, beauty and fitness services, engaging events and much more.



Restaurant, bars & lounges

Service will be adapted to respect social distancing: all meals and drinks will be served to guests at their table. At the buffet restaurant, self-service will be temporarily unavailable and the food will be plated and served to guests. For a contactless experience, guests will access restaurant and bar menus from their personal mobile device by scanning a QR code. To minimise risks, MSC Cruises has adapted the processes for ordering, preparing, delivering, consuming and paying for food and beverage services.

Shore excursions

Guests wishing to go ashore can only do so by participating in one of our MSC Shore Excursions to ensure the same high standards of health and safety ashore as on board. Excursions will be included in the cruise fare according to the experience booked (except for "cruise only" fare). Guests will be able to book additional MSC Cruises excursions.





Newly designed activities with smaller group sizes will be introduced with themed events, fun games, kids and family activities, talent shows, fitness, dance and more. A wide array of activities including shows, entertainment and the Kids Club will be available by reservation at no extra charge. Guests can browse the onboard programme digitally using MSC for Me digital channels* (mobile app, in-cabin smart TV, interactive touchscreens) and book their favourite activities by phone or in-person at dedicated desks. As the capacity of the theatre will be reduced to ensure responsible social distancing, the entertainment schedule will be extended so all our guests can still enjoy a great variety of award-winning shows.

All open decks will be accessible and pools, whirlpool baths and the aquapark will be available with a reduced occupancy to ensure social distancing. Sunbeds will be separated in clusters, sanitised after every use and deeper sanitation will take place every night.

An onboard Information Centre will be available by phone and remote desks will be set up on embarkation day to manage in-person questions in order to avoid queues. Guests should always call before going to any desk for information. In addition, guests will be encouraged to use digital services to find information such as MSC for Me* (mobile app, in-cabin smart TV, interactive touchscreens). Cashless payments will be highly recommended.



Rob prepares signature cocktails ordered by guests on specifically designed vertical digital cockpits with alcoholic, non-alcoholic and personalised options, just like a human bartender would do Rob can speak 8 languages (English, Italian, Spanish, French, German, Brazilian Portuguese, Chinese and Japanese), according to language chosen when the guest makes the order Each cocktail is served in custom-designed futuristic glasses that guests can be collected as a lasting souvenir of the MSC Starship Club experience.




Sir Bani Yas, United Arab Omirates

Interactive aquapark

MSC Virtuosa has one of the most exciting aquaparks at sea! Jump on three action-packed water slides including a champagne bowl and two racing tube slides.

Younger guests can play in the Aquaplay spray area and kids and adults alike can climb aboard the innovative Himalayan Bridge where guests attach themselves to a rope course and cross the ship, **80 metres above the water**.

Singing and dancing

Head to the pool deck or one of the ship's lounges for a dance class of salsa, merengue, ballroom and more. If singing is more your thing, head to the TV Studio for a karaoke session or go straight to the Attic Club where DJs get the party started to dance the night away.

In true MSC Cruises style, live music is performed in venues across the ship throughout the cruise. Guests can expect to hear up to **14 different music styles** from Pop to Rock, Jazz to Gypsy and Evergreens to Brazilian - all performed by **26 musicians** with flavours to suit every mood.
